Dear Members of the Carle Place Community,

We hope that the second half of the school year is going well for your family – as parents ourselves, we know how busy these next several months will be! In the midst of all the activities, we want to take this opportunity to provide you with an update on where the Board of Education stands in its search for a new superintendent of schools, as well as some other administrative changes.

We are pleased to report that we have had a tremendous response to our superintendent's search. To date, 48 qualified applicants have applied for the position – the majority of whom have a wealth of experience. Over the next several weeks, this applicant pool will be extensively researched and interviewed so that we find the best candidate to lead Carle Place Schools into the future. We expect to appoint a new superintendent later this spring, to begin work in our district on July 1, 2019. Of course, we will be sure to share any developments with you once a decision has been made.

In addition, the Board of Education will be interviewing candidates for a new assistant superintendent for business, a new executive director of technology and a new director of guidance for the start of the 2019-20 school year. The Board of Education extends its deep gratitude to Mr. Anthony Cedrone, Mr. Patrick Fogarty and Dr. Joy-Anne D'Anca, respectively, who are each pursuing other opportunities in their field of work. We are grateful for their years of service to Carle Place and wish them much success in their new positions.

Please be assured that even though a few administrative roles will be transitioning to new leadership for 2019-20, there are many things that remain constant in our district and there is much to celebrate! Our solid academic, co-curricular and extracurricular programs are intact, and the Board remains committed to providing students with increased opportunities for success at all levels. Our tradition of strong schools will continue well into the future thanks to our dedicated students, a committed faculty, staff and administrative team, and our supportive community.
