6. SEQRA Resolution for Middle School/High School Heating Plant Upgrades

6.1 WHEREAS, the Carle Place Union Free School District desires to embark upon a capital improvement projects at the Carle Place Middle/High School for the Heating Plant Upgrades and asbestos abatement at the existing facility and

WHEREAS, said capital improvement project at the Carle Place High School, is subject to classification under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

WHEREAS, replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes, unless such action meets or exceeds any of the thresholds in section 617.4 of this part, are classified as Type II Actions under the current Department of Environmental Conservation SEQRA Regulations (Section 6 NYCRR 617.5 (2)); and

WHEREAS, the SEQRA Regulations declare Type II Actions to be actions that have no significant impact on the environment and require no further review under SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Carle Place Union Free School District, as the only involved agency, has examined all information related to the capital improvement project and has determined that the capital improvement projects for the Heating Plant Upgrades and asbestos abatement at Carle Place Middle/High School are classified as a Type II Action pursuant to Section 617.5 (2), of the SEQRA Regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Carle Place Union Free School District hereby declares itself lead agency in connection with the requirements of the State Environmental Quality Review Act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Carle Place Union Free School District hereby declares that the Heating Plant Upgrades and asbestos abatement at Carle Place Middle/High School is a Type II Action, which requires no further review under SEQRA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Carle Place Union Free School District hereby shall forward an official copy of this Resolution to the New York State Education Department together with a copy of the correspondence from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation in connection with its request for approval of the listed projects from the New York State Education Department.
